## "A SHUTOUT!" AT GOP CONVENTION

Pro-life Republicans scored big at this year's New Hampshire Republican Convention held October 3. Our pro-life champion Sen. Bob Smith led off with a rousing, heartfelt speech exposing the hollow core of the abortion mentality. It was a tour-de-force speech so characteristic of the man. He declared the pro-life plank one of the "poles holding up the big tent."

Guest speaker Sen. John Ashcroft, presumably interested in the Oval office despite the current tenet, also defended the babies in his speech. Gubernatorial candidate Jay Lucas insisted he would sign a law banning partial birth abortions if the legislature could pass one. Unfortunately, the rest of our congressional delegation declined to defend the babies. Republican National Committee Chairman Jim Nicholson scrupulously avoided the subject.

In 1996 a substantially improved pro-life plank went in by a miraculous vote of 201 to 198. In the early stages of this year's platform development, the NHGOP Platform Committee sought changes to that plank which many pro-lifers concluded diluted its strength. A gallant contingent of pro-lifers gave an earful to the Platform Committee at a public hearing in Nashua. The next night, the Platform Committee announced at an Exeter public hearing that the 1996 language was restored to the draft...verbatim!

At this year's convention, the abortion crowd struck out on their proposal to slash the pro-life plank. A voice vote so strongly rejected the idea that the desperate abortion crowd didn't even ask for a formal count.

Victory was clinched by a vote on a measure seeking to stop the NH Republican Committee from funding candidates who defend partial birth abortions. The measure, proposed by NHRTL-PAC Chairman Ed Holdgate, declared the horrific nature of partial birth abortions (acknowledging that all abortions are equally repugnant) and then concluded, "THAT THE NH REPUBLICAN COMMITTEE SHALL NOT SUPPORT FINANCIALLY OR BY IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS ANY CANDIDATE OR NOMINEE OF THIS PARTY WHO OPPOSES MEASURES TO END SO-CALLED PARTIAL BIRTH ABORTIONS." Political hacks will recognize this as the "Lambert" language, named after a Texas National GOP Committeeman. Timothy Lambert tried to place this restriction on *National* GOP support in January.

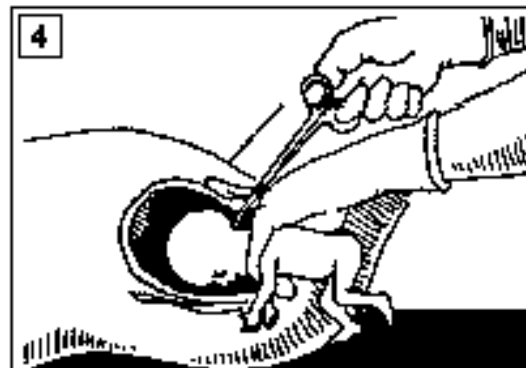
In the future when people ask, "Where were the American people during the abortion holocaust?" we will know where we were — supporting efforts to end the tragedy that has befallen our nation.

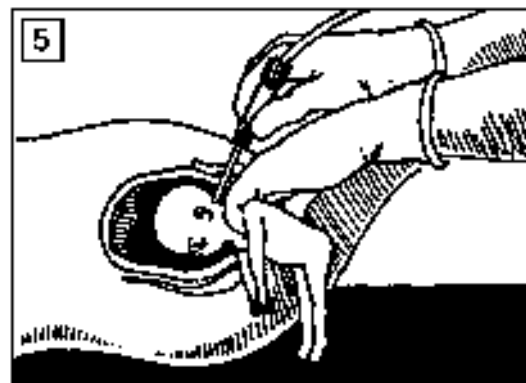

- 10:30 AM Two church services are scheduled. (A) Pro-life service at First Baptist Church, 20 North State St, Concord. All are welcome. (B) Mass at Sacred Heart Church, 52 Pleasant Street, Concord. All are welcome.
- 11:45 PM Assembly and rally on the **NH State House steps, 107 North Main St, Concord**. You are encouraged to make and bring your own pro-life signs and banners. ## President's Column

Are you getting discouraged about the condition of the right to life movement? It's easy to do. With each passing year, we seem to be sliding ever faster down the slippery slope. For example, within the last couple of years the New Hampshire state legislature wiped all of our pro-life laws off the books and defeated bills requiring that women be informed of the risks associated with abortion, of the connection between abortion and breast cancer, and that parents be notified of their minor daughter's intention to get an abortion. In addition, our radical pro-abortion governor continues to flaunt her allegiance to the abortion-on-demand minority and Planned Parenthood, the nation's largest abortion provider, continues to receive thousands of dollars of your tax money.

Are you upset about the way things are going? If so, what are you doing about it? Wringing your hands about the current state of affairs does nothing to reverse the pro-death onslaught. One thing you can do, however, is to help elect individuals to our state and national elective offices who will stand up for the right to life.

And so, I ask again: what are you doing about it? Are you registered to vote? If so, are all your pro-life family and friends registered? Some of them could probably use a little encouragement from you to take that first step. The next step is to make sure that all pro-lifers get to the polls on election day. Do some of your family or friends need transportation? How about baby-sitting? Why don't you take a moment right now to think of ways in which you can help get pro-life people to the polls. Also, if you know that you will be out of town on that day, you should plan now on casting an absentee ballot.

If the right to life is important to you, are you committed to voting only for those candidates who respect life? In order to do so, you may have to do a little homework. Have you checked on the candidates' position on abortion for the various races? For the local elections it is quite possible to call the candidate directly and ask his or her position on the issue. Why not call and ask if he or she would agree to the statement: \*. (P.S. You might want to get it in writing as well.) If the answer is "no," do they really deserve your vote? Can't find a pro-life candidate for a particular race? I am not above writing in "None of the Above" on the ballot in order to send the message that I cannot support a pro-abortion candidate, even one from the "right" party.

If you do find a good pro-life candidate running for office (and there are several this year), have you considered how you might help them? Most candidates for the state House, Senate, and Executive Council run their campaigns on a shoe-string budget. They can always use people who are willing to make phone calls (even if it is limited to people you know), distribute flyers at churches and other events, place signs on lawns and along the highway, and hold signs at the polls. It is important to let pro-life candidates know we appreciate their efforts and are willing to support them.

Someone once told me, "The only way to pass pro-life legislation, is to elect pro-life legislators." What are you doing about it?

## SUE YOUR DOCTOR FOR FAILING TO TELL YOU THE "PILL" IS ABORTIVE!

As I wrote in my last *NH Right to Life News* article, pharmacists, drug companies, and even the Supreme Court have known for years that everyday birth control pills and the IUD, in varying degrees, will prevent births by causing abortions. These "contraceptive" abortions add up to *millions of deaths more* each year than are committed in abortion clinics. Most of the abortions caused by the pill or IUD go undetected, sometimes as "spot bleeding", and without the woman ever being told she was prescribed what is scientifically and medically known to also cause abortions. But what can women do to correct this injustice? The answer is, plenty! If you want to see things change quickly, file a law suit against your doctor.

As stated above, everyday birth control pills and the IUD in varying degrees will cause a child to be destroyed and expelled from the womb in the earliest stages of development. Often this happens without the woman ever knowing it, unless perhaps, as stated above, she experiences "spot bleeding", which is reported by *Contraceptive Technology* and medical resources to be one symptom that the pill or IUD has induced an abortion (although such spot bleeding may also indicate a number of other conditions and need not indicate an abortion). When you speak to doctors about the abortive effects of the pill, they openly admit this is common knowledge among physicians. As one physician has repeatedly stated to me, "So what, we have known that for years." The silence of the medical community, therefore, when prescribing these pills and devices is unjustifiable! One young woman with whom I discussed these effects said "it is criminal" no one told her about this fact.

In the United States, 23% of all women between the ages of 15 and 34 were using the pill in 1990. By 1995 there were roughly 14 million pill users, and an estimated 2.5 million using Depo Provera, which is injected, and Norplant, which is implanted into the skin. There were also an estimated one million women in this country using the intrauterine device (IUD). By these statistics, we can calculate the number of abortions in the U.S. caused by chemical contraceptives and the IUD totaled 4.2 million in 1995 (2.2 million by chemicals and pills, and 2 million by the IUD). There were *over two and a half times as many contraceptive induced abortions* in that year as clinical abortions. There are over 4,000 clinical abortions each day in the U.S., hence there are over 10,000 "contraceptive" abortions each day in this country. These are likely conservative estimates. Civil law and the American Medical Association's standards of care require doctors to obtain *informed consent* before prescribing a treatment or chemical, which obligates them to disclose its known risks and potentially adverse effects. As one standard law office book reports: "*A rapidly growing form of medical malpractice litigation involves the doctrine of 'informed consent,' which concerns the duty of the physician or surgeon to inform the patient of the risks involved in treatment . . . [and] to provide their patients with sufficient information to permit the patient [herself] to make an informed and intelligent decision . . .*" The U.S. Supreme Court has ruled that, "*In attempting to ensure that a woman apprehend the full consequences of her decision, the state furthers the legitimate purpose of reducing the risk that a woman may elect an abortion [i.e., use an abortifacient procedure, pill, or device], only to discover later, with devastating psychological consequences, that her decision was not fully informed.*" *Planned Parenthood v. Casey*, 120 L Ed 2d at 718-19. (Bracket notation added to emphasize the traditional definition of abortion). This applies with greater force when a woman requests a "contraceptive", only to discover later she was prescribed what may have caused an abortion!

## **SEACOAST UNITED WAY HELPING ABORTION CLINIC** **Prolifers asked to give direct to charities instead of through the United Way**

The following article below, from the **Portsmouth Herald**, brings to the fore once again, our efforts to remove Planned Parenthood and its ilk from the ranks of your "friendly" neighborhood United Way. Several United Ways throughout New Hampshire support the killing of innocent preborn children through YOUR contributions to these United Ways. Despite our efforts over the years, United Ways such as Manchester and the Seacoast continue to include Planned Parenthood and abortion centers as recipient agencies.

There is no way to support these United Ways and not support the abortion agencies, as they are allotted certain amounts of monies at the outset of the campaign. Individuals may ask that their donations do not support such repugnant activities, but the agencies receive enough — or more — of others' donations (who have not directed their giving) to make up the difference. Therefore, the allotment to the abortion agencies is not diminished. ## **Activist may face charges** **Pro-lifer may have broken injunction**

GREENLAND — A pro-life activist who took offense at United Way volunteers sprucing up the Feminist Health Center on Tuesday may face charges after he allegedly trespassed on to the court-protected abortion clinic's grounds.

North Hampton pro-life activist Steve Priest, who came to the Portsmouth Avenue clinic Tuesday to videotape United Way workers taking part in the agency's Day of Caring, allegedly walked onto the grounds to ask the workers a question.

The move could make Priest the first Feminist Health Center protested to face charges in five years.

"It was a little out of the

ordinary," said Greenland Police Chief Scott Blanchard about the incident. "We haven't had any arrests for quite a few years."

Blanchard said his department will speak to the county attorney's office about whether to file charges against Priest, who allegedly broke a decade-old Superior Court injunction protecting the clinic's ground and air space from protesters.

The court injunction demands that protesters stay off the clinic's grounds and refrain from using loudspeakers to harass clients walking into the center.

Portsmouth's Warren Goddard, a former state representative and long-time pro-life activist, flanked Priest during the protest. He called

Priest's alleged trespass "an honest mistake."

The last arrests at the clinic took place in April 1993, when two pro-life activists stormed into the center and barricaded themselves in an examination room, police said. Two others barricaded the entrance into the clinic. All four were arrested for criminal trespassing and other charges.

Goddard said both he and Priest strongly objected to the Seacoast United Way sending volunteers to the clinic as part of its Day of Caring project aimed at helping area nonprofits spruce up their properties. As one of the country's largest nonprofit fundraisers, the United Way should maintain "neutrality" on the politically divisive abortion issue, Goddard said.

"Day of Caring? Wow. It

should tell people who give to the United Way never to do it again," said Goddard, whom police have arrested six times for sit-in protests at other clinics. "Apparently, they're in full support of the butcher shop."

But Susan Dewhurst, the Seacoast United Way's communications director, said the local board of directors, which operates separately from the national organization, decided to not exclude any nonprofit from volunteer help from 1,300 United Way supporters who fanned out through the Seacoast Tuesday to complete more than 200 separate projects regionwide.

## "Jane Roe" Works to Help Stop Abortions

Norma McCorvey is fighting to stop the very abortion procedure she helped make available to millions of women.

McCorvey is the "Jane Roe" of the Roe vs. Wade decision that in 1973 effectively legalized abortion on demand in the United States. But less than three years ago, she declared herself a Christian, severed her ties with the pro-abortion movement and went to work for a group that actively opposed abortion.

She spoke this [June] about her experiences to more than 700 people at a benefit dinner in Belleville. The event was sponsored by the Vitae Society of Missouri, a group that promotes options to abortion. In an interview before her speech, McCorvey, 50, talked about her change of heart and how that decision has affected her life.

"I don't have to go to the death camps anymore, to earn six bucks an hour," she said of her one-time job as marketing director of a Dallas abortion clinic. "I don't have the nightmares that I used to have, about seeing dead babies."

McCorvey now spends much of her time making speeches around the country. She also directs the Dallas-based Roe No More Ministry, an organization that provides information to pro-life groups.

In her second biography, "Won By Love," McCorvey says abortion proponents were uncomfortable with her rough exterior, the woman with a quick temper and a ninth-grade education.

"I was a heathen of the worst kind," said McCorvey, a short, cheery woman with a slight Texas drawl. "I sold drugs, I drank, did drugs, fooled around a lot. But I've been cleansed and saved by the blood of the Lamb."

McCorvey never actually had an abortion; she put all three of her children up for adoption. She said between 30 and 35 women have contacted her over the years claiming to be the "Roe Baby."

McCorvey said she's now content. "What I have is eternal life, and it feels wonderful," she said.

## Wisconsin Board Boots Planned Parenthood

JEFFERSON, Wis. — A Planned Parenthood office was evicted [in June] from its space in a county building, with supporters of the move saying the county should not be the landlord for the abortion agency.

The Jefferson County Board of Supervisors voted 18-11 against renewing Planned Parenthood's lease in the county health department building. The lease expires June 25.

Board member Mary Pat Klein called Planned Parenthood "extremely controversial" and that the agency did not belong in a county building. Abortions are not performed at the Planned Parenthood office, but the agency does provide referrals to abortion facilities.

The county has had a contract for various services from Planned Parenthood for 14 years.

## The Fire

An article in National Geographic several years ago provided a penetrating picture of God's wings. After a forest fire in Yellowstone National Park, forest rangers began their trek up a mountain to assess the inferno's damage.

One ranger found a bird literally petrified in ashes, perched statuesquely on the ground at the base of a tree. Somewhat sickened by the eerie sight, he knocked over the bird with a stick.

When he struck it, three tiny chicks scurried from under their dead mother's wings. The loving mother, keenly aware of impending disaster, had carried her offspring to the base of the tree and had gathered them under her wings, instinctively knowing that the toxic smoke would rise. She could have flown to safety but had refused to abandon her babies. When the blaze had arrived and the heat had singed her small body, the mother had remained steadfast. She had been willing to die so those under the cover of her wings would live.

## Baby Surprises Abortion Doctor

**Exam had shown only a 23-week-old fetus**

Police are investigating a Phoenix abortion clinic where a doctor delivered a full-term baby he had intended to abort.

The surprise birth occurred after an examination by clinic personnel showed the baby was only in its 23rd week, police said, and the doctor prepared to abort the fetus.

Instead, he ended up delivering a full-term, 37-week-old baby.

Police and Maricopa County Attorney Rick Romley said Wednesday that they had not yet determined whether any crime had been committed in connection with the incident June 30 at the A-Z Women's Center on East McDowell Road.

"Of course we're going to look at this," Romley said. "We will also do research on the law and reserve judgment until the investigation is complete."

Phoenix police Sgt. Mike Torres said detectives are still investigating, but, "at this point, it doesn't appear anybody will be charged with anything."

Calls to the A-Z Women's Center were not returned Tuesday.

The baby's mother is a 17-year-old woman who came to the clinic June 29 after a home pregnancy test turned up positive, police said. Police did not reveal her identity.

An ultrasound examination performed at the clinic showed her to be 23.6 weeks along in her pregnancy; the clinic will abort fetuses up to 24 weeks, police said.

During the abortion procedure the next day, police said, Dr. John Biskind realized the fetus was full-term, and delivered a 6-pound, 2-ounce girl. The newborn was taken across the street to Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center.

The child, who suffered a skull fracture and two deep lacerations, will be adopted by a Texas couple, Torres said. She shows no signs of brain damage.

Biskind, who has been licensed in Arizona since 1981, has been investigated in the past. In 1996, he was censured by the state Board of Medical Examiners for "gross neglect/conduct harmful to patients or the public," according to board records. *{Reprinted for educational and discussion purposes only, not for commercial use.}*

## St. Anselm's and Fleet Bank Helping Sex/Abortion Promoter Child Health Services

For the second consecutive year, New Hampshire Right to Life picketed PEGGOSUS, a family concert held at St. Anselm College's Dana Center, in September. The concert was a benefit for Child Health Services (CHS). CHS promotes free sex, birth control and abortions to minors behind parents' backs.

At the Manchester Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention Conference, June 13, 1997, I heard Dr. Selma Deitch, director of CHS, publicly reveal her strategy for counseling minors whom she suspects of being sexually active. She explained that she separates them from their parents, questions them, then schedules them for a pseudo-follow up appointment, such as tonsillitis or acne. Under this guise, she ensures kids access to birth control, so they will have "responsible" sex.

It is not surprising that Child Health Services works closely with Planned Parenthood, the primary baby-killer in the nation. Child Health Services' Annual report ('95-'96) documents this alliance:

1. In 1994, Child Health Services received a grant from the NH Bureau of Maternal and Child Health, for collaborating with Planned Parenthood Teen Options clinic in the Manchester Community Health Center.

2. CHS sponsors the Manchester Youth Theater (MYT). Since 1989, MYT has used peer education to indoctrinate thousands of students in Planned Parenthood's free sex, anti-life philosophy.

3. CHS received a CATCHGRANT to plan a new Manchester Teen Clinic whose staff and board are related organizationally to CHS. In July 1998, Dr. Deitch announced the clinic's opening at the YWCA on Concord Street. The clinic offers general health care, as well as confidential reproductive counseling.

Hence, Planned Parenthood is spreading its tentacles at an even broader spectrum of teens, who may not be promiscuous—yet. The clinic targets "the underserved and unaccounted for",

a seemingly noble mission which masks the eugenic agenda of population control. Planned Parenthood "helps" the poor by promoting the killing of their offspring. Society is thus "served" by reducing their numbers.

### What can you do?

1. Educate others about Child Health Services.

2. Encourage citizens who care about family values to bypass CHS fund raisers.

3. Find out if your church or civic organization contributes to CHS. Many do. If so, persuade them to stop.

The bodies were illegally dumped in a field by a truck driver for a Los Angeles abortion clinic. He was caught in 1997 and had to serve 71 days in jail. The grave is at Crestlawn Cemetery, marked with a headstone showing the names of all the children.

## Fair Season Was GREAT!

### Many THANKS to our supporters and volunteers!

Once again, New Hampshire Right to Life took the pro-life message to the public by way of fairs. NHRTL exhibited booths at the Hopkinton State Fair and the Hillsborough County Fair this summer.

The Hopkinton State Fair, which ran from September 3 to 7, is one of the largest fairs in the state. This year, approximately 138,000 attended the fair over the course of five days. The Hillsborough County Fair was the following weekend, September 11 to 13.

"The goal of having a booth at the fair is to educate people who might not otherwise take the time to think and read about the issue of the right to life," said Philip Morrison, organizer of the Hopkinton State Fair booth. "I believe that people are much more willing to take a look at the literature or to ask questions in that type of setting than at a picket or demonstration." Our presence at a fair puts a personal face on the pro-life activist often missing in the mainstream media.

All the materials shown in the photo were available by donation, but offered free upon a direct request. The sustaining support from NHRTL donors enables these booths to run.

Morrison credits the twenty-nine volunteers who staffed the booth over the course of the five days of the Hopkinton fair for making it possible. "Without the volunteers, several of whom spent many hours at the booth, this educational opportunity would have been impossible." Teenagers passing by our booth were often captivated by the preborn baby video we left running. It was *particularly* helpful to have other teens, like Chrissy and Beth, deliver the pro-life message and offer literature. A big thank you to all our volunteers!

This is the second year in a row in which NHRTL had a booth at both of these fairs. NHRTL expects to expand our participation in New Hampshire fairs every year because they are both encouraging to our volunteers and very rewarding. Several people recounted how pro-life witnesses, pro-life literature, and even news accounts about pro-life activists influenced their decision to keep their baby.

"Ultimately, I would like to see a booth like this at every fair in the state," said Morrison. "It is important to take the pro-life message to where the people are."



## The **PILL** is **ABORTIVE** From Pg. 4

In *Roe v. Wade*, the Supreme Court cites rules of the American Medical Association which protects the right of each physician and hospital to object as a matter of conscience to being involved in the performance or prescription of "any act violative of personally held moral principles," including the prescription of any known abortifacient pill or device. (*Roe v. Wade*, 410 U.S. 113, 144, n. 38). The same right to protection from being *manipulated* or *coerced* into using or distributing birth control that is also abortive now extends to pharmacist. A Catholic News Service reported in the July 6, 1998 issue of *Tidings*: "[P]harmacists in South Dakota may legally choose not to dispense drugs that would cause an abortion . . . if they feel doing so violates their conscience. . . . 'All this law does is level the playing field,' said Dan Wunrow, executive director of the South Dakota Right to Life. 'This bill will give pharmacists the legal protection that the rest of the medical community has had for years.' 'For many years laws have protected the conscience of medical personnel who would refuse to take part in something that would conflict with other moral, ethical and religious convictions'. . . [N]ow, more than ever, pharmacists needed to be protected from dispensing deadly medications."

That bill was allegedly prompted when a Catholic pharmacist employed by the Indiana Health Service Clinic refused to provide a "morning after pill" that would *prevent the implantation of "a fertilized egg"* into "the uterine wall", which is one of the known risks of everyday birth control pills. Now pharmacists in South Dakota have the same protection as doctors from being coerced by state laws or "reforms" into participating or engaging in actions that violate their personally held moral and religious conviction *that preventing the implantation of a fertilized egg or embryo is in fact the murder of a fully conceived human child!* The *right to refuse* includes the *right to know* the truth about the "pill" and IUD as a precondition to the *free exercise*, without coercion or deception, of that right to refuse to participate in providing or using such potentially abortive pills or devices.

These laws protect the fundamental right of doctors and pharmacists to believe that the conception of human life begins at fertilization. *But what about women?* If the medical community is so careful to protect the rights of its physicians to refuse to prescribe known abortifacient methods of so called "contraceptives", they have *at least an equal duty* to protect the same right of each woman to whom they prescribe what they represent to be a "contraceptive". In every other area of medicine, the doctor must advise women about known risks of a drug or treatment, and obtain their full and informed consent to its risks and mechanisms by which it achieves its intended effects, including abortive effects. Consistency requires doctors to make certain each woman fully understands the birth control method she is prescribed is also known to be inherently abortive. Yet few doctors prescribing the "pill" or other methods tell women this, despite the Supreme Court's ruling in *Webster v. Reproductive Health Services* that a State or individual has a constitutional right to hold and believe that the conception of new human life occurs at "fertilization", and to enact State laws defining "conception" as taking place at "fertilization", thereby classifying the "pill" and IUD, in keeping with "[s]cience and medicine", as also being "abortifacients". (*Webster*, 492 U.S. at 504-6, 539 n. 1, 563; Oral Arg., Wash. Post A16, April 27, 1989).

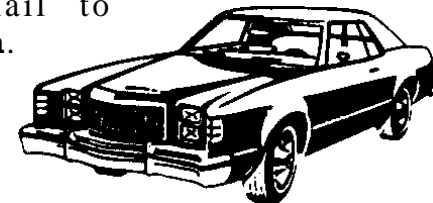
*The time for law suits is overdue!* The makers of the pill and IUD and doctors have known since at least the mid 1960s that the "pill" and IUD are abortive, as documented in medical journals like *The Journal Of The American Medical Association (JAMA)*. It was the filing of law suits by victimized and angered women that changed the medical carelessness in other areas of medicine, including other contraceptive, as well as women's issues, forcing doctors to become safer with the lives and "right to know" of women, and

their children. The threat of losing revenues, paying large jury awards, and increased insurance policies and settlements made doctors more careful with women in those areas. It is past time for women to require of doctors the same carefulness toward each woman and her personal respect for all human lives when prescribing the "pill" or IUD.

If you or someone you know have been deceived into risking human lives without being told by your doctor what you were doing, and you would be willing to take a stand for human life and women's rights by filing a law suit, please contact me at (603) 624-2085, or at P.O. Box 1665, Manchester, NH, 03105. This is one area in which I am concentrating my legal efforts as an attorney practicing in this state, at least in order to evaluate your case and to refer it to an appropriate attorney if I am not able to take on another case myself at that time. I am confident you have an excellent claim to receive a monetary jury award or settlement, if not also punitive damages. All it takes is for you to have your case evaluated. The initial evaluation meeting is free. I pray that we can all work together to bring an end to this tragedy. Anyone who wishes to help finance couples who decide to bring legal actions to end such *medical deception* and abortions, please contact me as well.

## The Starfish Allegory

Many pro-lifers know the starfish allegory, especially those so committed to saving babies that they sacrifice time and treasures to go to the clinics for sidewalk counseling, prayers, and pickets. In case it has escaped your notice, however, I include my rendition:

**A beach was covered with millions of starfish, slowly dying in the baking hot sun as the tide receded. A little girl was on the beach, diligently picking up one starfish at a time, and tossing it back into the sea. An older man happened by and saw the hopeless sight. He interrupted the girl and asked, "Little girl, why are you doing that? There are millions of starfish. You cannot hope to make a difference." The little girl looked up, and without a hint of despair, replied, "I've made a difference to this one" as she tossed another starfish into the sea.**

Clearly, this story above applies to pro-life sidewalk counselors seeking to make a difference to a relatively few babies compared to the 1.5 million babies aborted each year. Nonetheless, those prayerful, often tearful, sidewalk counselors and indeed all those helping pregnancy care centers carry on, sacrificing to save a baby here and a baby there.....making a difference. It's a great ministry.

However, some pro-life worker-volunteer-activists are troubled that other pro-lifers are not doing the "right" things. We have disagreements within our movement about legislation, about rape, incest and life of the mother exceptions, about candidates for office, about fund-raising, and about insisting how other pro-lifers must work. There are many areas of disagreement, and recognizing the disagreements is a big step towards forging resolutions.

I want to help soften our perspective of each other. Please do not assume I am singling out any individual or group of pro-lifers with my expository completion of the starfish allegory. It is meant to clear up my perspective too:

**The man shook his head and left the girl alone on the beach. Later, a few children came by to help. The first little girl showed them how to toss the starfish into the sea. More children arrived. Some children were afraid to touch any starfish that was misshapen or broken, so the first little girl was called and she bravely saved those starfish. She was proud of her special role. All the other children raced to save the healthy starfish. Thousands were saved as the children sang.**

**As dusk fell, there was grumbling. "Soon our Father will call us in, and there are still dying starfish!" The first little girl insisted everyone work harder and save all the starfish, even those misshapen and broken. Many were still afraid. Most of the children were very tired, and some, upset from the complaints and bitterness, left the beach. More starfish died and night fell upon the beach. There was not enough children.**

**With nothing but moonlight, the older man returned to find the forlorn little girl still working. With resentful eyes she cried out, "Why did you abandon me? You could have saved hundreds today! All these children came to help, but I had to save the misshapen and broken ones myself!" And she wept.**

**The man whispered an explanation past the lump in his throat, "After we talked, I went to the playground behind these woods, and I sent all those children to help you." The girl's lips quivered. She demanded, "Why did you send me children who would not help me save the misshapen and broken ones?" The man answered, "You were once satisfied to just make a difference to one starfish at a time. One at a time. One. It's true, I didn't save any starfish myself. But the children I sent helped you save thousands, and their help freed you to use your special gift of brave compassion for saving the misshapen and broken starfish."**

**The little girl understood. Together they slowly walked off the beach, planning how to save more starfish tomorrow. Then, under the cover of night, at the Second Coming, God sent in the tide and saved all the starfish left on the beach.**

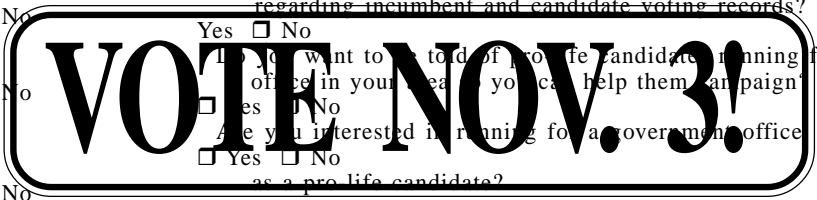

**Political**

The New Hampshire Right to Life Political Action Committee qualifies candidates for public office with respect to how strong they are on life issues. We survey the candidates, check their voting records and affiliations, and then publish the results of our findings in our newsletter. Many of our members want to help pro-life candidates get elected to public office. We often help to identify those candidates in your local area who are pro-life, so that you can personally make sure they win the election and get the opportunity to defend the babies. ## Life Principles

We hold these truths to be self-evident: That all human beings are created equal by their Creator with certain inalienable rights, among which is the right to life; and therefore:

The right to life of each human being shall be preserved and protected by every human being in the society and by society as a whole, and

The life of each human being shall be preserved and protected from the biological beginning throughout the natural continuum of that human being's life by all available ordinary means and reasonable efforts, and

The life of each human being shall be preserved and protected at each stage of the life continuum to the same extent as at each and every other stage regardless of state of health or condition of dependency, and

The life of each human being shall be preserved and protected to the same extent as the life of each and every human being regardless of health or condition of dependency, and

When there is any doubt that there exists a human being's life to preserve and protect, such doubt shall be resolved in favor of the existence of a human being, and

When two or more human beings are in a situation in which their lives are mutually endangered, all available ordinary means and reasonable efforts shall be used to preserve and protect the life of each and every human being so endangered.
