Grievous Errors by NH Bush-Cheney Campaign

The NH Bush-Cheney re-election campaign, led by Julie Teer, accidentally made a grievous, but correctable error. "She could have fixed the mistake when I asked privately and quietly," said NHRTL President Ed Holdgate.

Some background on the matter: Planned Parenthood, the nation's leading abortion industry, leases their Manchester abortion clinic on Pennacook Street from the Metropolis Property Management Group, 33 South Commercial Street (www.metropolispmg.com / 666-4518). While Metropolis cannot be said to run the abortuary, they can be said to "own" an abortuary. NHRTL vigorously opposed the opening of the facility, and we implore everyone leasing property from Metropolis to halt their relationship with this rabidly pro-abortion establishment.

In a painful revelation 3 weeks ago, NHRTL discovered that the NH Bush-Cheney campaign has leased their Manchester headquarters from this very same Metropolis group. The professing "pro-life" Bush-Cheney team of NH is therefore leasing space from a group that also "owns" an abortuary. Some portion of donations to NH Bush-Cheney would apparently flow to an abortuary owner.

Julie Teer, to her credit, insists the Metropolis connection to the abortuary was not realized when they took up residence, and we believe her. On behalf of the babies, and in earnest opposition to those promoting abortion on demand, NHRTL President Ed Holdgate privately asked Julie Teer to find another location for the Bush-Cheney campaign headquarters. "Three weeks later, I sensed the campaign has no such intention and concluded such seething hypocrisy justifies this public exposure," he said. "Their inaction suggests a hardened heart against the unborn, a forfeiture of pro-life integrity, an undermining of President Bush's pro-life position, and an insult to genuinely pro-life Republicans. Pro-life sentiment from the NH Bush-Cheney campaign will ring fraudulently hollow unless their compounded error is corrected by leaving the building possessed by an abortuary owner," he said.
